Agreement on the conditions for the organisation of the webconference

between

the Secretary General of the Council of Europe, 67075 Strasbourg Cedex, France, represented by Carmen MORTE GOMEZ in her capacity as the Head of the Case-Law Information and Publications Division of the European Court of Human Rights, hereinafter referred to as "the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights",

and

the Academy of Justice of the Republic of Armenia, Armenia, 0054, Yerevan, 9 Pirumyanner st., represented by its Rector Mr Sergey V. Arakelyan, hereinafter referred to as the AJRA.

The Parties have agreed to the following conditions regarding the organisation of the two webconferences with the title "Recent case-law of the European Court of Human Rights." ("the presentations") which will take place on 12 and 13 December 2017.

1. Duration

The first presentation will last approximately two hours and will be followed by a Question and Answer Session. The second presentation will last approximately one hour and will be followed by a Question and Answer Session.

2. Recording of the presentation

The presentations may be recorded by the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights and/or the AJRA by common agreement. In such case, the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights as the owner of the intellectual property rights over the presentations authorises the AJRA to use the recorded presentations for purely internal, educational purposes. This excludes in particular making them available on an internet site or transmitting them to third parties. The use for such or any other purposes requires the prior approval of the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights. The Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights reserves the right to share the recorded presentations with other partners or to make them available to the public on its website. In this case, the AJRA will be informed in advance.

The Question and Answer Session may not be recorded.

When using the recorded presentations the AJRA shall give proper credit to the persons giving the presentations, indicating that they are Judge of the European Court of Human Rights and lawyers at the Registry of the European Court of Human Rights and that the presentations do not bind the Court. The Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights stresses that the presentations are based on the Court's existing case-law at the time and that the case-law may further evolve within a short period of time.

3. Interpretation and translation of subtitles

Should any interpretation or translation of the presentations or the Question and Answer Session be necessary, the AJRA shall obtain those at its own costs and shall request from the interpreter or the translator a full transfer of the intellectual property rights over the translation. The AJRA shall authorise the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights to share the interpretation and/or translation of subtitles with other partners or make them accessible to the public on its website.

4. Use of the logos of the European Court of Human Rights

The AJRA may not use the European emblem, the logo of the Council of Europe or the logo of the European Court of Human Rights without the prior authorisation of the Council of Europe/European Court of Human Rights.

5. The Court's multilingual Twitter account

The webconferences may make reference to the Court's Twitter account which allows followers to stay informed of translations and related Court news in their own language. The partner accepts to promote this account by ensuring that its address is on display during the event as well as promoted in any communications preparing or following up on the conference: <https://twitter.com/echrpublication>

6. Disputes

Any disputes as regards the organisation of the webconferences or the application or interpretation of the present conditions shall be settled amicably without recourse to any form of national legal process.
